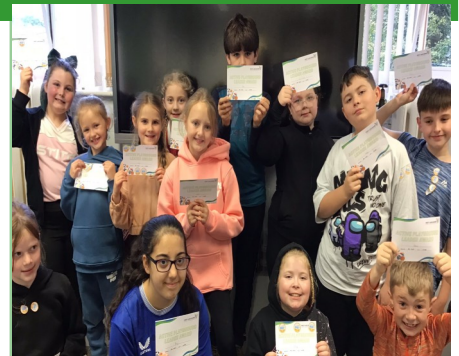
### *This week's key question:*
