All our pupils have started the year fantastically with super behaviour and excellent effort in our learning and in getting used to our school routines.

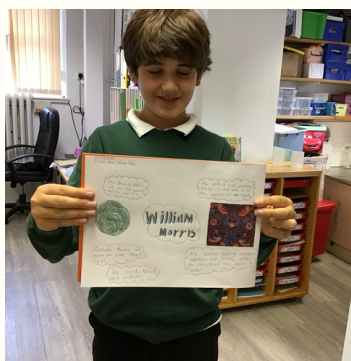

All of our new pupils who have settled so well.

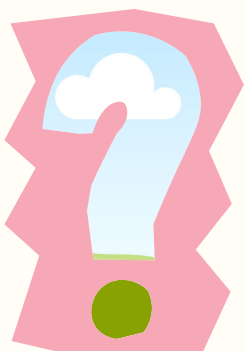
